Clinical Projects Under Development

The Traumatic Brain Injury Hormone Dysfunction Syndrome: (www.tbimedlegal.com) Wartime neurotrauma affecting the emotional status, cognition, and physical functioning of our returning GIs, can be very subtle. Often times, these can be precipitated by non-penetrating head trauma from explosions originating from automatic weapons, hand grenades, IEDs, bombs, and explosive charges. All degrees of causation have been placed into the classification of Post-Traumatic Stress Syndrome (PTSS). Under PTSS the secondary hormone deficiencies are overlooked. The Millennium Health Centers, Inc. has received private funding and corporate grants to pursue the interviewing and laboratory testing of 100 returning veterans. We are in the process of screening patients. See more at the web site.

The Traumatic Brain Injury HDS Workshop: Planned as a 3 day intensive course, this work shop will utilize the pending book TBI: A Clinical Approach from Diagnosis to Treatment to train healthcare providers how to interview, examine and treat those suffering from head trauma with a hormonal impact. Expected course in the last quarter of 2010.

The Traumatic Brain Injury Prevention Certification: A one day CME course focusing on both sports and non-sports related head trauma. Being knowledgeable about causes that can precipitate the sequela associated with TBI is similar to learning about CPR and the Heimlich maneuver. This course will be available in 2011.
